We have designated car parking areas. Depending on which room your event is in, we would recommend one of two car parks. No parking permits are required except on match-days.

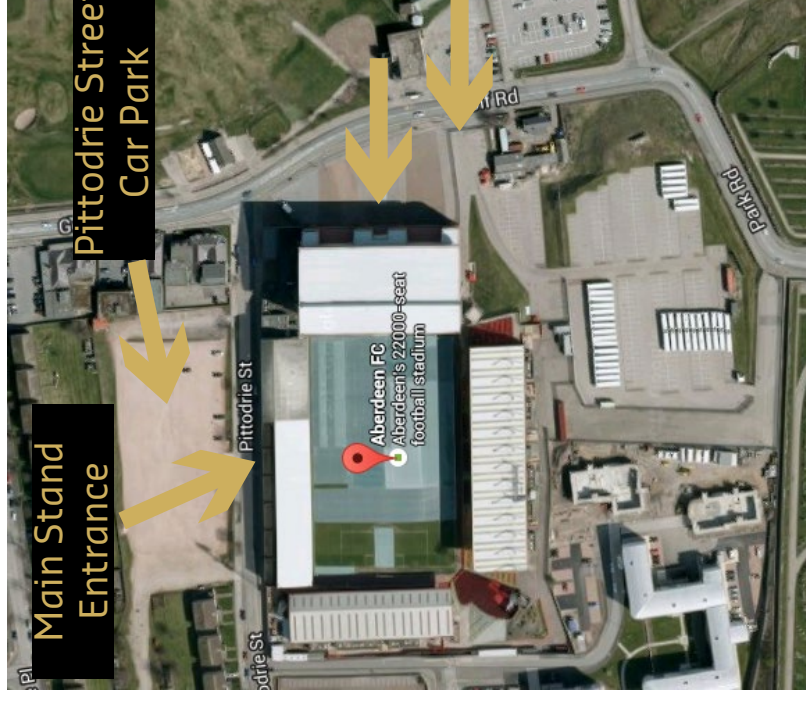
